PART I: LISTENING COMPREHENSION (140 MARKS)

A. DIÁLOGOS 9 + 10 + 10 + 9 = 38 marks

Question 1 = 9 marks (3 + 3 + 3)

- a) Bookshop 3m
- b) **Two** of: when you get to the traffic lights, cross the street
there is one just opposite the Police station. 2+1m
- c) Shops usually close at 8.30 pm 3m

Question 2 = 10 marks (4 + 3 + 3)

- a) Spanish football jersey / t-shirt for her 15 year old son 2+2m
- b) His size 3m
- c) €60 3m

Question 3 = 10 marks (3 + 4 + 3)

- a) **Two** of: access to all rides 3m
- b) **Two** of: Roller coaster, water rides, bumper cars, train (for the little ones) 2+2m
- c) Fast access to rides 3m

Question 4 = 9 marks (2 + 4 + 3)

- a) Swimming lessons for children (at the moment), finish in fifteen minutes **2m**
b) **Two** of: cap, goggles, flip-flops **2+2m**
c) At the end of the hall **3m**

B. UNOS ANUNCIOS 10 + 10 + 10 + 10 = 40 marks

Question 1 = 10 marks (4 + 3 + 3)

- a) Go to platform 3, the train is leaving in 5 minutes **2+2m**
b) Smoking, put your feet on the seats **2+1m**
c) Restaurant in the last carriage, free Internet access in Wi-Fi area,
(password is RENFE) **2+1m**

Question 2 = 10 marks (4 + 4 + 2)

- a) **Three** of: storms, heavy rain, north winds, snow in mountain areas **2+1+1m**
b) **Three** of: cloudy in the morning, clear skies in the afternoon, dry, sunny **2+1+1m**
c) Max. 13°C Min. 9°C **1+1m**

Question 3 = 10 marks (4 + 3 + 3)

- a) All shopping has 25% discount [2m] in electric appliances, IT,
home hardware and children's clothes departments **2+2m**
b) **Three** of: beds, bedside tables, side boards / dressers, armchairs **1+1+1m**
c) **One** of: Spend more than €30 in cash, pay with shopping centre card **3m**

Question 4 = 10 marks (2 + 6 + 2)

- a) Paella competition **2m**
b) **Three** of: rice, meat, seafood, vegetables, saffron and condiments **2+2+2m**
c) **One** of: an apron, a cooking hat and a cooking video **2m**

C. UNA NOTICIA = 12 marks (4 + 4 + 4)

- a) **Two** of: to learn a language for free, have fun **2+2m**
b) **Two** of: listening, talking, translating, writing and multiple choice **2+2m**
c) You can learn a language anywhere, at any time, improving your Spanish
without realising **2+2m**

D. DESCRIPTIVO = 50 marks (26 + 24)

Question 1 = 26 marks (6 + 2 + 6 + 6 + 6)

- a) **Two** of: he established an intercultural exchange in the 60s, was a journalist,
an Olympic athlete, an adventurer, died two years ago **3+3m**
b) To have dinner in the Royal Palace with the King of Spain/Felipe VI **2m**
c) **Two** of: cultural exchange, protection of the environment, international cooperation
and adventure among Spanish speaking youngsters **3+3m**
d) **Three** of: sleeping bag, cotton socks, swimming suit, flashlight, toothbrush,
water bottle **3+3m**
e) Stroll regularly, have your hair cut very short,
not having piercings (to avoid infections),
keep your clothes in plastic bags inside the rucksack **3+3m**

Question 2 = 24 marks (6 + 6 + 6 + 6)

- a) All the Instituto Cervantes centres opened their doors to the public to celebrate The International day of Spanish **6m**
- b) **Two** of: second most spoken language in the World, 560 million speakers, third most used language on Internet, 21 million students of Spanish in the World **3+3m**
- c) **Three** of: tasting tapas, wine and cheese, competitions, films, workshops, visits to the libraries **2+2+2m**
- d) **Two** of: Spanish, flamenco, art, cinema, literature **3+3m**
