SPANISH CONDITIONAL

- Regular Verbs -

- One of the **easiest tenses** in Spanish to conjugate!
- The endings for the verbs are **ALL** the same:

-ar

-ir

-er

hablar -ía

comer -ías

construir -ía

comprar -íamos

producir -íais

fluir -ían

SPANISH CONDITIONAL

- Irregular Verbs -

- There are only **12 irregular verbs** – only the **root** changes – endings same as regulars

caber → **cabr-**

querer → **querr-**

decir → **dir-**

saber → **sabr-**

haber → **habr-**

salir → **saldr-**

hacer → **har-**

tener → **tendr-**

poder → **podr-**

valer → **valdr-**

poner → **pondr-**

venir → **vendr-**

The Conditional

- 3 Uses -

1. Talk about **imaginary** situations
2. Give **advice**
3. Express **hopes** for the future

Tip!

When we use "WOULD" or "SHOULD" in English.

*~ You **SHOULD** study more, Mick.*

*~ I **WOULD** love to study medicine at Uni.*

The Conditional

- Use 1 -

EXPRESS IMAGINARY SITUATIONS

*Con un millón de euros... **tendría** una fiesta grandísima y luego
me compraría un apartamento grande en Andalucía.*

*¡Qué hambre tengo... **me comería** una vaca!*

*I'm starving ... **I would eat** a horse!*

The Conditional

- Use 2 -

EXPRESAR DESEOS – EXPRESS WISHES

Typical
VERBS



condicional + infinitivo

Gustar

Me gustaría ir de vacaciones a Granada.

Encantar

Me encantaría estudiar medicina.

Desear

Desearía comprarme un Ferrari.

The Conditional

- Use 3 -

DAR CONSEJOS – *GIVE ADVICE*

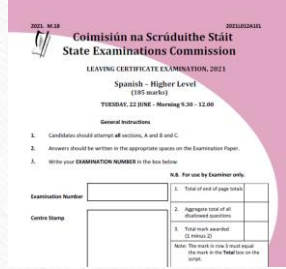


- **Tendrías que** + infinitivo
- **Deberías que** + infinitivo
- **Habría que** + infinitivo

Tendrías que estudiar más.

Deberías que beber menos alcohol.

Habría que proteger el medio ambiente.
